



Memorandum of Understanding Between

Jordan Europe Business Association (JEBA)

And

Spain Chamber of Commerce

Memorandum of Understanding

The Party A and Party B hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"

Considering the mutual aspirations towards the establishment of closer contacts between the entrepreneurs of the two countries,

Taking into account new opportunities to develop mutually beneficial trade and economic relations.

Desire of taking the advantage of the most recent efficient forms of cooperation in joint economic activities,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Parties shall take all opportunities within their competence to promote, strengthen, and expand trade, economic cooperation and other business relations between companies, enterprises, entrepreneurs and organizations of Jordan and Spain.

Article 2

The Parties shall exchange information of mutual interest on economy, foreign trade, trade rules and customs, as well as on amendments regarding trade legislation and other information materials.

Article 3

The Parties shall promote and expand mutually beneficial forms of cooperation between enterprises, firms, entrepreneurs as well as associations of the Party A and the Party B.

Article 4

The Parties shall render assistance in organizing seminars, conferences, and promote exchange of visits.



Article 5

The Parties shall render necessary assistance to enterprises, firms, entrepreneurs as well as their participation in international, national and specialized exhibitions and other information of the events held in Jordan and Spain

Article 6

The Parties shall cooperate in rendering assistance to enterprises, firms and entrepreneurs on the issues of interest to their members

Article 7

The Parties shall work on coordinating joint meetings between the businessmen from both countries aimed at promoting cooperation, trade exchange, and find joint business opportunities without incurring any legal liability arising from these projects.

Article 8

Both parties agreed to create a data base for economic opportunities and projects which will be available in both countries on their websites.

Article 9

Both parties will not incur any financial obligations and/or legal liability arising or which may arise from the implementation of MOU terms.

Article 10

This MOU shall come into effect on the date of its signing and will remain valid until notice of its termination given in writing by either Party in which case MOU shall be terminated three months after the date of the written notice.
